

Photo workshop mountain landscape
Italy, Dolomites, 19 to 21 September 2014
Three days of photo shooting in the beautiful mountains
(mountains, water, macro)

Number of participants 7-8

Dolomite is undoubtedly one of the most beautiful mountain ranges in Europe. Places and routes where we will move during a photo workshop leads the most exciting areas of these mountains. Thanks to the possibility of departure by a small bus, we will be able to reach places that lies at an altitude of 2,200 meters. Spectacular views of the valley and surrounding rocks of bizarre shapes are guaranteed. We will visit the picturesque mountain villages with churches, mountain lakes with crystal clear water, we will shoot the Queen of the Dolomites - Marmolada - 3342 m high. Each participant shall have travel insurance, everyone is going on their own risk!
Have: photo backpack with photo equipment, tripods, filters, trekking boots, suitable clothes to the mountains, gloves, cap, headlamp, food, beverages, money for breakfasts or dinners and the cable car (40,- Euro).

Thursday 18. 9 : departure from Čkyně, meeting at 8pm in front of house no. 189 opposite the school, departure at 9pm through Strážný, Passau, Salzburg, Silian

Friday, 19.9. : Misurina lake, walk around the tower Tre Cime di Lavaredo
Then through Dobbiaco (Toblach) Toblacher See, Durren See, Lake Misurina (view of the group Sorapis and Tre Cime di Lavaredo), a small lake Antorno, drive on a the toll road to the parking lot in 2320 km to cottage Auronzo (arrive early in the morning, photographing the sunrise with a beautiful view of the group Cadin, Sorapis, Mt. Cristallo), comfortable walk along the road under the "tower" of solid rock Three Peaks (3001 m) to the cottage Lavaredo, further to the cottage Drei Zinnen Hütte overlooking Lake Bödenseen. Amazing landscapes of the Dolomites, work with tripod, panoramic images, the use of polarization and graduated filters. Less experienced returns to the cottage Auronzo, proficient complete circuit around the Three Peaks back to chat Auronzo, total of about 5-6 hours on foot. Drive back to Lake Misurina, shooting near a mountain lake. In the afternoon, tour the mountain town of Cortina d'Ampezzo. Afterwards drive to accommodation.

Saturday, 20.9. : Passo Giau, over the Passo Falzarego, Pordoi, in view of the Marmolada and Sasso Lungo

Early morning shooting from Passo Giau, then crossing to Passo Falzarego (splendid views of the Marmolada glacier massif at 3342 m), Arabba, Passo Pordoi 2242 m, a cable car lift to Sass Pordoi 2952m for views of Tofani, Sorapis, Antelao, Pelmo, Civet, Marmolada glacier 3342 m, Latemar and to Sella region. One of the most beautiful circular views of the Dolomites. Walk down to cottage Forc. Porcia 2848 m down to Passo Pordoi. Less experienced can go down by the cable car lift. The more experienced can get up to the top of Piz Boe at 3152 m. In the evening departure back to the accommodation for the night.

Sunday, the 21.9. : Through Passo Sella to the view of the Sasso Lungo and Passo Gardena

Early morning shooting in Paso Giau area, drive around the towers on the Sella massif to Passo Pordoi (photographing rock towers in the massif of the Sella and Sasso Lungo 3181 m), then to Passo Gardena, back through the Plan de Gralba. Down over ST. Kristina, ST. Ulrich to Ponte Gardina and onto the highway, through Brenner, Innsbruck, Kufstein, Munich and back to Čkyně. Arrival in the evening.

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The price includes:

Complete transport to the Dolomites, including Austrian highway fees, motorway fees in Italy, accommodation in cottage

The price does not include:

Breakfasts and dinners, food and drinks during the trip to the Dolomites, cable car fees.

Exact location of accommodation to be confirmed, supposedly under saddle Giau and Cortina d Ampezzo.
